Priority Rec Projects by Ranking

- 1. Bead Lake Loop Trail
- 2. Bead Lake Loop Trailhead (North)
- 3. Off Highway Vehicle (OHV) Connectors: Browns Lake/CCA Roads
 - a) Cee Cee Ah Browns Creek: Connects the Browns Lake Road System with the CCA Road System through a series of Forest Service Roads.
 - b) Cee Cee Ah Creek Road (NFS 1920): Currently open to highway legal vehicles only. Connects to IPNF
 - c) Browns Creek Road (NFS 1921): Currently open to highway legal vehicles only.
 - d) Browns Lake Road (NFS 5030): This road is currently open to highway legal vehicles only.

Priority Rec Projects (con.)

- 4. Mill Creek Road (NFS 1200): Currently open to highway legal vehicles only.
- 5. Cooks Lake Road (NFS 5015): Currently open to highway legal vehicles only. We would also recommend that Cooks Lake Campground be opened to OHV use.
